Oltjen Orthodontics Creates New Practice for Advancing Technology and Care with Four Regional Offices

Dr. Jay Oltjen, DDS, MS Launches Independent Practice Focused on Innovation and Special Treatment

Overland Park, Kan. (June 2, 2010) –Dr. Jay Oltjen, DDS, MS is leveraging his 15-plus years as one of the region's most prominent orthodontists to create his own practice, Oltjen Orthodontics. Formerly with Hannah & Oltjen Orthodontics, Oltjen launches Oltjen Orthodontics as he assumes full ownership of four existing offices on June 1, joined by many familiar faces from the staff that has treated generations of Kansas Citians. Dr. Oltjen is implementing the most up-to-date orthodontic procedures and technologies, as a way to provide patients shortened treatment periods and reduce the number of appointments, resulting in time and financial savings. Dr. Oltjen firmly believes in and will personally provide a high level of care to every patient throughout every phase of their treatment.

Oltjen Orthodontics will operate out of regional offices including Olathe and Overland Park, Northeast Kansas in Atchison, and just south of Johnson County, in Paola. Oltjen Orthodontics has newly finalized plans to construct an Olathe office building on the Southeast corner of 151st and Blackbob that is anticipated to open in the Fall of 2011. Both doctors will practice in the existing Olathe office while Dr. Oltjen develops his new Olathe location. Dr. Hannah will assume operation of the Lenexa and Emporia offices. "In order to realize my goals for Oltjen Orthodontics, I felt it was important to modernize my Olathe office space to include a larger, more comfortable reception area and technical advancements including digital x-rays and computers at every chair. Therefore, I sold my interest in the Olathe building to Dr. Hannah," says Dr. Oltjen.

New Technology

Oltjen is perfecting the art and science of smiles by building on and expanding his innovative practice philosophy. 3M considers Dr. Oltjen among a select group of orthodontic advisors that participate in efforts for the advancement of orthodontic products and development. He is among the first orthodontists in the nation to review and introduce cutting-edge procedures. He continues to be a lead advisor in the development and application of an orthodontic three-dimensional scanner that is the evolution of orthodontics by replacing the old-school plaster molds with a scan that reproduces patients' mouths for accurate digital bracket placement. Currently, Oltjen is participating in a limited-trial of a new low profile ceramic bracket, combining aesthetic enhancements with a more comfortable clear bracket.

 allows monitoring a child's growth out of baby teeth to avoid problems and shorten treatment
